Not supported  The land will be zoned Public Use Zone 6 Local Government (PUZ6).  A long term, wholistic perspective is taken of the council's intentions. The council land is 1.68 hectares in size, large enough to add significant public open space to expand Woodland Park and to provide a community facility such as a kindergarten. The PUZ6 allows the council to provide both public open space and community facilities without the need for a planning permit. Whereas the PPRZ would impede the
	provision of any community facility by the council. The counci will undertake consultation about the provision of community facilities in the area.
