Apologies for the delayed response. I'm still coming to terms with the amount of email I have returned to after two weeks leave.

Barwon Water and DSE are still in the midst of discussions regarding the potential impact on the MGI of the proposed grassland reserve to the west of Werribee. Until this matter is resolved, Barwon Water will not be in a position to lodge any planning applications or referrals, including the EES referral. Our schedule for the resolution of this issue brings us to just before Christmas. Therefore, we will not be looking to lodge the EES referral application until late Dec or early Jan.
